



Fronter is again in the lead with collaborative learning technology - now able to offer all Fronter users the Bridge functionality. The Bridge provides a way for Fronter users to share content and collaborate in rooms across Fronter installations.

With the Bridge

Bridge between schools - Fronter users in separate installations will be able to collaborate.

Apply for membership - Teachers/students will be able to apply for membership in rooms located in different Fronter installations.

Share resources - Students/teachers working in more than one Fronter installation will be able to create common Fronter rooms where all can share content, have discussions, and work together.

How does the Bridge work

Top administrators – Top administrators will have access to establish a Bridge or 'Trust' between two Fronter installations.

Users – The users will not need separate usernames for different Fronter installations. All internal and external rooms can be accessed from within their own Fronter installation.

Invitation to collaboration – Users can invite other user groups to join or collaborate in common resource/discussion rooms between Fronter installations.
