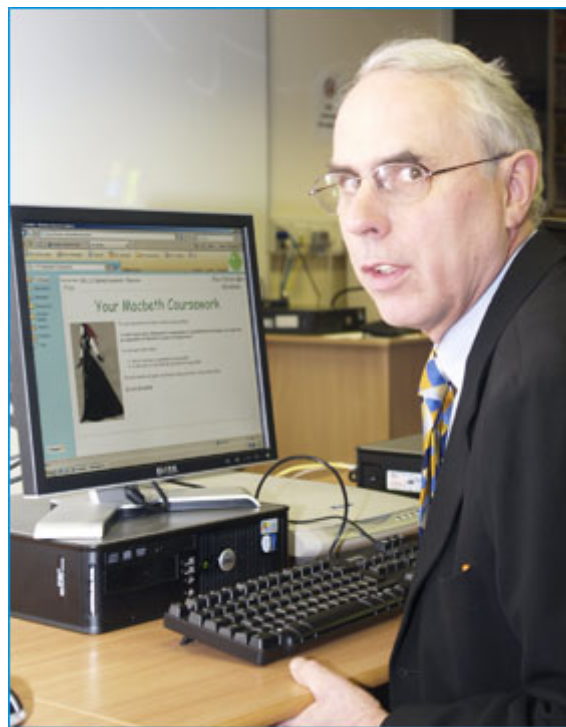

Success for the London MLE: Camden School for Girls

The London MLE in practice at Camden School for Girls (CSG) has proven a successful project that will definitely be continued in the future. Thanks to the summer 2007 pilot program of the new London MLE, CSG has taken the next step in 21st century education.

'The school implemented Fronter as part of the London wide pilot in summer 2007. CSG was unusual in enrolling over 400 students and staff in the pilot, so convinced were we that it would work successfully.'

With an already advanced ICT department led by Mr Clifford French, CSG has approximately 300 personal computers available to students and staff, and has equipped every classroom with interactive whiteboard and computer. Rated as 'Outstanding' by the OFSTED inspectors, CSG saw the London MLE as a means of continuing and enhancing the high standard of education and facilities that has already been established.

Positive results have been seen especially with those students who were difficult to engage, but 'are now producing more work because Fronter is being used to provide guidance in an attractive format that they can access both in class and at home.'

With the 'FrontPage' tool, every classroom involved in the pilot has an attractive start page where students and teachers could then access resources, learning paths, tests and hand-in assignments. 'The "tests" tool is being used in ICT and is part of a PE Department virtual classroom at an advanced design stage on Drugs in Sport. Students enjoy being able to practice and develop skills through taking a test as many times as they wish.'

CSG is currently setting up a virtual staffroom which will provide for quick and efficient communication amongst staff and most importantly, easy access to documents and resources that need to be given out.

With a very positive response from Students, parents and staff, Camden School for Girls is ready to take the next step forward from the London MLE pilot and move into the next generation of education with online learning platforms.
