Why Parental Log-in

Real time access - Key information on a student's progress, attendance, school activities and participation.

Stay up to date - Parents can stay up to date and have an impact on their child's life at school.

Communication - Promotes an open relationship between parents and teachers, ensuring the child receives maximum support and guidance at school and at home.

How Does Parental Log-in work

Parents:

Each parent will be assigned their own **Fronter username and password**, giving them access to their child's school portfolio and absence/attendance records.

Teachers:

Communicate to parents, information on a student's progress, attendance and behaviour with parents.

Administrators:

Customise parental access to a student's account.

Decide who has the right to create a parental account.
